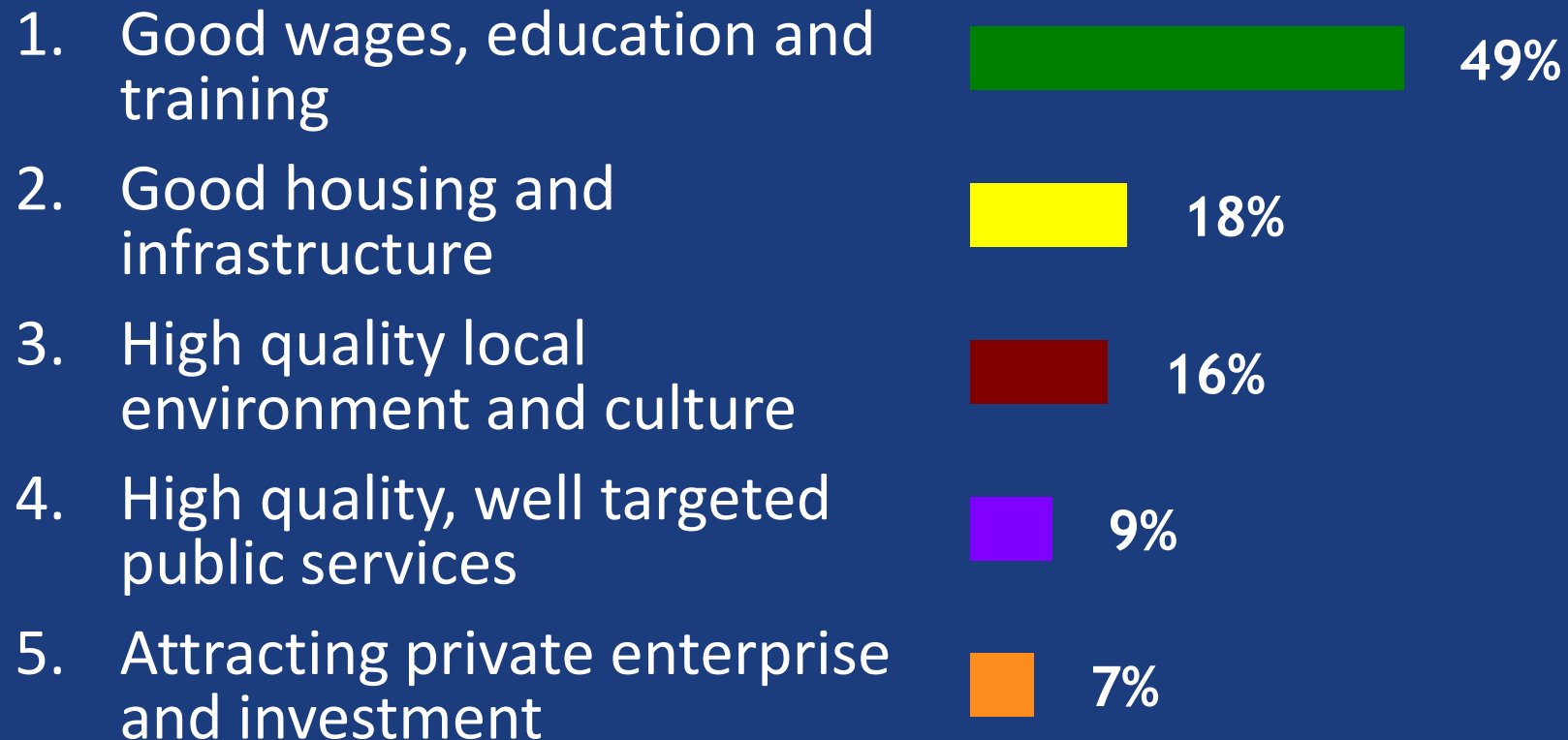

1. Reducing the inequality gap between people in different income groups wherever they live  51%
2. Reducing the inequality gap between longstanding rich and poor places  49%
